NORTH COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NOTICE OF ELECTION OF MEASURE TO BE VOTED UPON AT THE OCTOBER 24, 2019 ALL-VOTE-BY-MAIL AND DEADLINE FOR FILING BALLOT ARGUMENTS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following measure are to be voted on in a Special All-Vote-by-Mail Ballot election to be held in the North County Fire Protection District, County of San Diego, California on Thursday, October 24, 2019.

COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT No. 2019-02 (FIRE STATION CONSTRUCTION AND CAPITAL REPLACEMENT

PROPOSITION A: To avoid a significant reduction in the level of services presently being provided to residents throughout North San Diego County, shall the North County Fire Protection District be authorized to levy a special tax at a flat rate of \$5/month (\$60/year) per parcel of property owned, to be used for construction, capital improvements and deferred maintenance of fire stations, raising approximately \$1 million per year, with an initial appropriations limit of \$20 million, and independent annual audits and citizen oversight required?

SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST PROPOSITION

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN if Member or members of the Board so authorized, or any individual voters who is eligible to vote on the measure, or any bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument for or against this measure.

Primary arguments shall be titled either "Argument in Favor of Measure A" or "Argument Against Measure A"

Primary arguments for or against a ballot measure can be up to 300 words in length. Arguments must be typed or printed. No handwritten arguments will be accepted.

A ballot argument will not be accepted without the printed name and signature of the author. An argument may have up to five (5) signatures. If there are more than five signatures, only the signatures of the first five will be printed. Each argument signer must also complete a **Signature Statement**.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN if more than one argument for, or more than one argument against, measure is filed before the deadline, the Board Secretary will select one of the arguments. When the Board Secretary has elected the argument in favor and against the measure, the Board Secretary will send a copy of the argument in favor to the author of the argument against and a copy of the argument against to the author of the argument in favor. The authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not exceeding 250 words. The rebuttal arguments must be filed with the Board Secretary by **August 19, 2019 by 5:00 p.m.** Rebuttal arguments shall be printed in the same manner as the direct arguments. Each rebuttal argument shall immediately follow the direct argument, which it seeks to rebut.

Rebuttal arguments shall be titled either "*Rebuttal to Argument in Favor of Measure A*" or "*Rebuttal to Argument Against Measure A.*" Rebuttal arguments can be up to 250 words in length. No handwritten arguments will be accepted.

Signers of rebuttal arguments need not be the same as those on the primary arguments for or against a measure. However, if signers of the rebuttal arguments are different from those of the primary argument, the "Release for Rebuttal Argument" form must be completed and filed, indicating the name of the person signing the primary argument and the name of the person signing the rebuttal argument in their place.

There is a *ten-calendar day* public examination period for the impartial analysis and primary and rebuttal arguments, immediately following the deadline for their submissions.

Arguments must be typed and formatted in block paragraph style. Limited use of **bolding**, CAPITALIZING, underlining, *italics*, center text and bullets (small solid circle only) are permitted. Do not use profanity or other objectionable language.

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All arguments and rebuttals must be filed with the North County Fire Protection District Board Secretary located at 330 S. Main Avenue, Fallbrook, California by the filing deadline as outlined herein.

Please be accurate, arguments will be printed exactly as submitted; spelling, punctuation and grammatical errors will not be corrected by the Board Secretary. Interested persons are advised to contact the Board Secretary at (760) 723-2012 prior to the filing deadline of August 19, 2019 for required forms, additional information and guidelines.
